Wilderness First Responder

Please check with the course instructor or the WMA office if you have questions about or problems finding this gear. Plan on having all gear acquired before the course begins so that the instructor can review it. Students should not be required to use their own personal equipment for the course.

Classroom Equipment (Required):

- Adequate classroom space, chairs, and desk space for students
- Adequate space (inside and outside) for hands-on practice
- Electricity, multi-outlet extension cords, as needed
- PowerPoint/LCD projector
- Large-size whiteboard (blackboard as a second choice)
- Projection screen
- Color TV/monitor (preferably large-sized) or suitable device (e.g. LCD with speakers) to play back videotaped simulations
- Desk space for instructional materials and paperwork

Miscellaneous Equipment (Required):

Your course will require a supply of typical outdoor equipment for use as improvised medical gear such as splints and stretchers. Try to use what you have on hand. Begin by going through retired equipment that you have used on trips because these materials will get used heavily in class and on simulations. Focus on environment-appropriate pieces. A pair of snow shoes in the tropics does not make sense. Please follow the quantities below:

Disinfectant (i.e. dilute bleach solution in sprayer bottles)	2	2
Stokes, baskets or other rigid litter	1	2

Simulation (cuttable) clothing*	See note	

* Clothing is used for simulations. It will be cut up, bloodied and used for padding. In case students forget to bring their own, this can be acquired at Goodwill, or over at thrift stores in bulk. Have several sets available.
